Cardiovascular disease (CVD) is a major cause of death in Australia, with 43,477 deaths (nearly 30% of all deaths) attributed to CVD in Australia in 2017. CVD kills one Australian every 12 minutes and is one of Australia's largest health problems. There were over 1.1 million hospitalisations for CVD in 2015-16 (11% of all hospitalisations). Despite improvements over the last few decades, it remains one of the biggest burdens on our economy. (www.heartfoundation.org.au www.aihw.gov.au)
